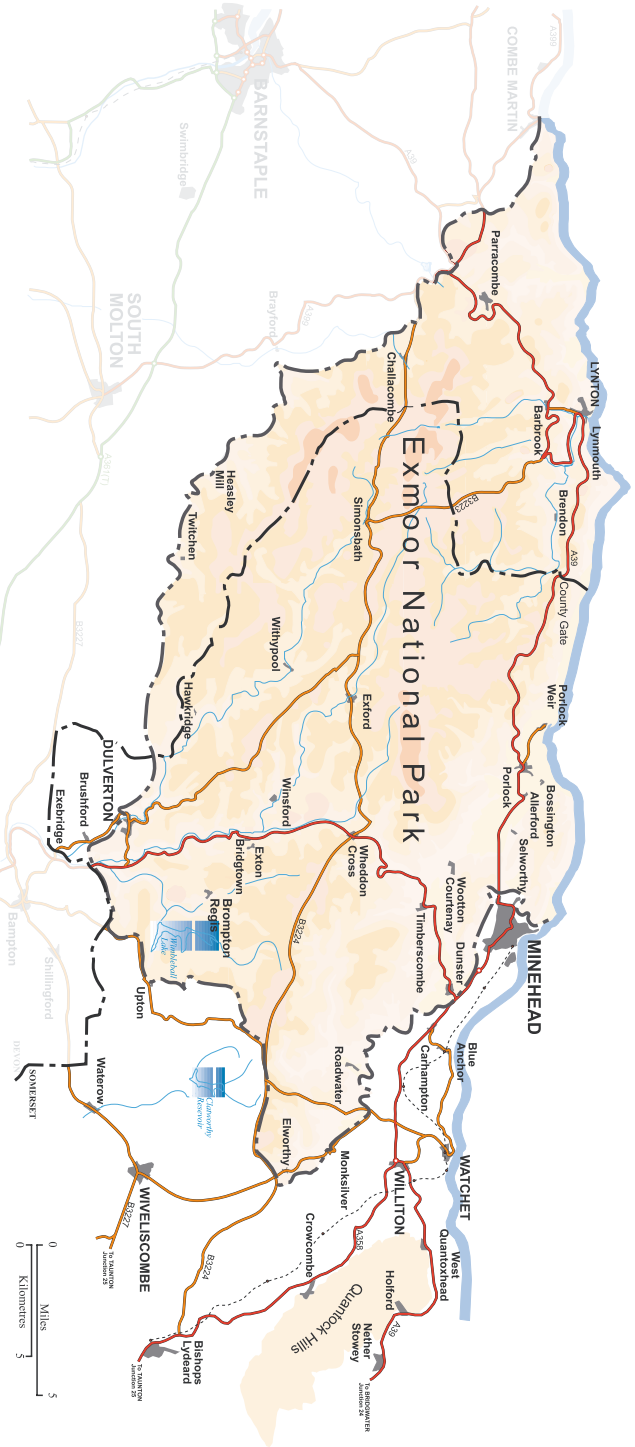


Moor Rover Bus

 The Moor Rover provides a flexible bus service for residents and visitors to enjoy walking, cycling or any leisure or sporting activity in Exmoor National Park.

The Moor Rover primarily operates within Exmoor National Park, as detailed above, where other public transport is not available. Please call for further information and to discuss journeys outside of this area.

How does the service work?

The Moor Rover can pick you up and drop you off at any pre-arranged point within Exmoor National Park. (Please contact **ATWEST** to discuss journeys outside this area including along the Coleridge Way).

Individuals or groups can book. The Moor Rover bus has 16 seats and will transport passenger's wheelchairs, dogs and cycles. **ATWEST** buses are all **fully accessible** and drivers are trained in passenger care and wheelchair loading.

**THE SERVICE WILL OPERATE ALL YEAR ROUND
7 DAYS A WEEK FROM 8.00AM TO 8.00PM.**

Book your journey in advance between 9.00am and 4.00pm at least the day before you wish to travel. There is no weekend booking service.

Arrange your pick-up time and destination drop off point with the scheduler. Let us know if you require a return journey at time of booking.

A flat rate single journey fare is charged as follows:

SINGLE Fare	£6.00 each
CHILDREN up to 16	£2.00 each
GROUPS of 4 or more people	£4.00 each
BICYCLES and DOGS	£1.00 each
LUGGAGE TRANSFER SERVICE	£6.00
